## Bridging the Divide: An Experiential Masterclass in Science Diplomacy

An intensive one- to two-week mobility programme that equips scientists, diplomats and policy practitioners to bridge foreign policy, scientific innovation and sustainable development through science diplomacy.

Participants build practical skills in communication, negotiation and strategic leadership through lectures, workshops, case studies and site visits. The programme concludes with the Co-Design Lab, where interdisciplinary teams develop practical solutions to transboundary challenges.

Aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the programme promotes evidence-informed policymaking, resilient institutions and international partnerships.
